QUADRANGULAR TOURNAMENT

In a reversal of last year's results where Dunedin were the winners, Canterbury has won the Mens and Womens Southern Quadrangular representative bowls tournaments held in Oamaru on Saturday. Canterbury men beat Dunedin 6-0, Sth Canterbury 6-0, and North Otago 4-2 to finish well clear and win the Jolly Trophy.

Such was the dominance of the Mens team only the Fours suffered a loss in the three rounds played. Both Gary Lawson playing Singles and the Pair of Glen McDonald skip and Roger Glendenning recorded three wins.

In the Senior Womens competition Canterbury emerged the winners overall by one match point from Dunedin. Serena Mathews playing singles for Canterbury Women was the mainstay of the team in winning her 3 games whilst Sandra Keith's Four also remained unbeaten with two wins and a draw. The draw in the Canterbury Four's third game was the decider to winning overall, getting the two shots on the last end to draw the game and gain the vital match point.

The Mens and Womens Development tournament results were much closer with the Canterbury Mens team just beating South Canterbury after being tied on 10 match points and winning on differential by 2 whilst the Women's Canterbury team finished third behind Dunedin and South Canterbury. The standout performance was the up and coming Tayla Bruce playing Singles for the Canterbury Womens Development team with 3 wins from her three games.
