

BURNSIDE BEATS SOUTH BRIGHTON IN INTERCLUB BOWLS MIXED TENS

The Burnside Club has won the Bowls Canterbury Interclub Mixed Tens competition beating last year's runnerup South Brighton decisively in the final 9-3 on the Papanui Club green on Thursday evening.
