

# BELFAST WINS INTERCLUB SEVENS

The Belfast Club have won both Division One and Two of the Bowls Canterbury Interclub Sevens after winning both finals on the Fendalton Centre Green yesterday.

Belfast's wins entitles them to represent Canterbury at the Zone 5 BNZ Interclub 7's to be played at the Burnside Club on the 3rd-4th March.

In Division One the strong Belfast team won all three games in defeating the Canterbury II team 6-0. Gary Lawson playing singles for Belfast 1 was in superb touch controlling the game from the outset to win easily 25-6 over Mark Lewis from Canterbury in a game played predominately on shorter ends with Lawson scoring on 13 ends to Lewis's 5.

Both the Pairs and Fours games were closer although the Fours game was unfinished after the Pairs had been won by Belfast's Adrian Robins and Nigel Godman 18-15.

In Division Two the result was closer with Belfast winning 4-2 over the Burnside Division II side. Ricky Cook continued his good form in singles play with a clear win proving too steady for Burnside's Grant Ellis 25-14 and the Pairs and Fours were shared with the decider being the Fours, won by Steve Ford's Belfast Four 21-16.
