

BOWLS CANTERBURY EARTHQUAKE APPEAL

There have been many messages of support from around New Zealand to our fellow Cantabrians affected by and are suffering after the earthquake.

In Canterbury we have 19 bowling clubs whose 29 greens have been badly affected by liquefaction and many buildings are in need of either minor or major repairs after the earthquake on Tuesday 22 February.

This earthquake poses some huge challenges for many Bowling Clubs and the sport in Canterbury will be seriously affected. Currently we are gathering information from Clubs so we know the extent of the challenges and we propose to use Consultants to take a coordinated approach of advising Clubs on rebuilding and project management through this difficult time.

The reality is there is no direct funding to help Clubs so we have set up an appeal fund so that persons or Clubs wishing to donate to the Bowls Canterbury appeal fund that will be used to assist coordinate the rebuilding of the affected clubs.
